

ROUND HILL FIRE TOWER LOOKOUT

Take care on this road, as it is not regularly maintained and is quite narrow in certain sections

– **4WD recommended.**

This lookout is close to Batemans Bay and offers terrific views of Batemans Bay and the surrounding areas, including the Clyde River. It also offers views of the hinterland areas south and west of the Bay.

Take the Princes Hwy south of the Visitors Centre, past the industrial area and on towards Mogo/Moruya, 2.8km from the Visitors Centre you will see a sign on your left "Round Hill Fire Tower". From this road take the right hand fork, travel approximately 0.8km to the look out and Fire Tower.

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There are many more scenic viewing spots in the area but these are a few to get you started.

At Nelligen there is a lovely picnic spot up near the old church in Braidwood Street where you can view the far reaches of the Clyde River and watch the boats as they cruise along.
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MORUYA HEADS LOOKOUT

Take the Princes Highway south from the Visitors Centre to Moruya (27km). Follow the Highway through Moruya, turn left into South Head Road (opposite the golf course). This road is very scenic with views to the river on your left. Once at the Heads there are several opportunities to view the ocean particularly at the old graveyard at the tip of the Heads. On a still day this is a lovely spot for a BBQ.

MELVILLE POINT LOOKOUT

TOMAKIN

Follow Beach Road from the Visitors Centre to Tomakin approximately 21km (Beach Road becomes George Bass Drive along the way). Turn left into Ainslie Parade and this road will lead you into Red Hill Parade. At this junction turn right and continue until you reach the lookout. A magnificent spot to view the coastline.

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BIG BIT LOOKOUT

This lookout is located in the north end of the shire. Take the Princes Hwy north from Batemans Bay. The turn off for the lookout is approx. 14 km from Batemans Bay on Big Bit Road (or about 5 minutes past the Benandarah service station). The road is unsealed but in good condition.

After approx. 4 km you will reach the lookout where you can enjoy 360° views of the surrounding area including Durras Lake. You can continue along this road back to the Highway but as the going is quite steep you may prefer to head back the way you came in.

FOLDERS HILL LOOKOUT NORTH BATEMANS BAY

Located in north Batemans Bay, this look out offers great view towards the Tollgate Islands. Take the Princes Hwy north from the Visitors Centre, cross the Bridge and take the Canberra Road (Kings Highway) by turning left at the first roundabout. Turn left again at the second roundabout into Old Punt Road and then the second turn right into Penthouse Place. Follow this street to the very top of the hill. The lookout is a vacant lot on the left (not signposted).

HOLMES LOOKOUT

You will find this lookout only 5 minutes from Batemans Bay. It offers spectacular views of Batemans Bay and the Clyde River including the Bridge and Estuary. The look out also offers superb views northwest to the rugged Budawang Range and north to Pigeon House Mountain.

Take the Princes Highway north from the Visitors Centre, over the Bridge and take the first turn left at the roundabout, which is the Kings Highway (to Canberra).

Continue along this road for 2.7 km until your reach Rotary Drive on your left and you will see a signpost for "Holmes Lookout". There are Picnic tables and BBQs at the lookout.

OBSERVATION HEAD LOOKOUT BATEHAVEN

This lookout is located in Batehaven approx. 5km from Batemans Bay. From the Visitors Centre take Beach Road along the coast and head towards Batehaven. Drive past Corrigans Beach and through the traffic lights, winding up the hill then turning left into Observation Avenue. Follow this road out to the headland and park your car in the car park.

From here you are free to enjoy the serene views over the Bay and out to sea. Take a walk along Corrigans or Caseys Beach to fully enjoy this area.

BURREWARRA POINT LOOKOUT GUERILLA BAY

From the Visitors Centre follow Beach Road towards Batehaven and admire the coastal scenery as you travel past the suburbs of Batehaven, Surfbeach, Lilli Pilli, Malua Bay and Rosedale. The turn-off to Guerilla Bay is 18.2 km from Batemans Bay and is well signposted. Turn left into Burri Point Road and follow this road to the very end where you will find a small car park. (Ensure you stay on Burri Point Road and don't take the left turn into Beach Parade – save this beautiful area to explore after your walk.)

From the car park proceed on foot out to the lighthouse lookout. This 15 to 20 minute walk is easy and takes you Banksia and heath vegetation. The views up and down the coast are breathtaking and offer great photo opportunities. Keep a watchful eye open for dolphins (at any time) and whales (in season, mid Sept to end Oct). While at Guerilla Bay, explore the rest of this beautiful coastal haven, as the swimming/diving area down by the beach is one of the most picturesque spots in the shire.
